



FOUR WINNS TH36

The new Four Winns TH36 is a bold departure for the French-owned builder since this introduction launches a new range of outboard-powered catamarans not previously offered. This sizable bowrider (38' 5" LOA, 14' 7" beam) is a Marc Lombard design with sleek lines and a "suspended" hardtop that seems to defy gravity. An outdoor galley, twin dinettes, and plenty of modular sunbed space (both forward and aft) create lots of comfortable on-deck living, but there are also two ensuite cabins below so weekendening this fun cruiser is tempting. The dual console design places the helm to starboard with a companion seat to port and a walk-through windshield in the middle. Fifteen guests can easily separate into small groups between the aft and forward cockpits. Power is provided by twin 300-hp outboards upgradeable to 350s and with 144 gallons of fuel, this swanky runabout can stretch her legs. A smaller version of this true entertainer is expected soon. Leopard 40 PC

Joining her 46- and 53-foot siblings, the new Leopard 40 PC (40' LOA, 21' 8" beam) is the perfect size for two owners with occasional guests. This Simonis Voogd design was expected to have many of the same features as the two larger models but on a much smaller platform. The naval architects dialed in the weight and trim with computational fluid dynamics (CFD) and delivered an exceptional compact yacht. Inside is the signature L-shaped galley, a workable salon, and lower helm, which is unusual on a cat in this class. Below, the entire starboard hull is dedicated to the owner's suite with two more cabins in the port hull. The flybridge has the upper helm, a U-shaped dinette, and an optional summer galley. VisionF 80 BLCK

The Turkish VisionF 80 BLCK debuted in Europe and word spread quickly about this mysterious matte-black creation that looks like James Bond just zoomed by. This aluminum yacht (78' 6" LOA, 31' 4" beam) is powered by twin Volvo Penta IPS 1050 diesels capable of delivering a top speed of 18 knots. Aggressive yet elegant, she can carry a Williams Jet Tender as well as a PWC on her acres of flush deck. The Black Edition is fairly customizable with lots of layout options. An enormous master suite is in the starboard hull with still enough room for another double cabin on that side. It's all about guest comfort and privacy from the posh flybridge, to the sunken lounge on the foredeck, to the privacy screen aft which shields onboard visitors from any lookie-loos staring in from the quay when the boat is Med-moored.
