Day 1: Thursday, May 2nd

Rock Sound

1 PM Arrive in Rock Sound Harbour. As we see you arrive and get settled in, we will bring your welcome bags to your boat.

3 PM Meet on shore to visit the caves. Dock your dinghy at Wild Orchids Waterfront Restaurant.

6 PM Gear up for our annual White Out Themed Welcome Dinner! Don your brightest whites as we enjoy dining and drinks at Wild Orchids Waterfront Restaurant. Let's set the tone for an unforgettable week!

Dinner will be a buffet with an open bar from 6-8. Apps will include chicken wings, conch fritters, and meatballs.



Day 2: Friday, May 3rd

Ten Bay Beach

8:30 AM Pull up anchor to set sail for Ten Bay Beach. The cruise will be about 20 nm (~3.5 hours, weather dependent)

1 PM Your lead crew will organize an all-boat raft up at Ten Bay.

Day 3: Saturday, May 4th

Island Farm Tour & Governors Harbour

9 AM Meet at Runaway Bay Marina to walk one mile to the Eleuthera Island Farm. Farm Tour will begin at 9:45 am. Boats can either dinghy from Ten Bay Beach to Runaway Bay Marina (1.5 miles) or move north and anchor in Runaway Bay.

1 PM Head North to Governors Harbour for the evening anchorage. It will be an 8 nm cruise. (~1.5 hours)

6 PM Meet at the Buccaneer Club for Happy Hour. Drinks and light appetizers will be provided. *Yeehaw! Saddle up in your finest saltwater cowboy attire and lasso that prize at happy hour!



Day 4: Sunday, May 5th

Hatchet Bay

9 AM Pick up anchor and head to Hatchett Bay. This is a free afternoon, so if your boat prefers to travel later, it is up to you! Hatchet Bay is about 16 nm from Governors Harbour.

6 PM Fiesta time at Boater's Haven Bar and Grill! Join us for a Cinco De Mayo Happy Hour with drinks, appetizers, live music, and dancing. Let's celebrate! There is a dinghy dock conveniently located at the restaurant.

Day 5: Monday, May 6th

Glass Window Bridge

9 AM Pull up the anchor and head to the Glass Window Bridge. The best anchorage will be just south of the Glass Window.

12 PM WEAR YOUR FLOTILLA SHIRTS TODAY and meet on the beach. The first stop will be the Queen's Bath before heading .5 miles to the iconic Glass Window Bridge, where we will capture a photo of the whole group.

Tonight is wide open, with no plans in sight. How about an impromptu Happy Hour at the Glass Window Bar and Grill, or perhaps a group sunset with sundowners on the beach? The choice is yours for the perfect way to unwind.



Day 6: Tuesday, May 7th Spanish Wells

MORNING (TIME TBD) Set sail for Spanish Wells. The trip is about 22 nm.

1 PM Optional swim and snorkel stop at Egg Reef off Egg Island

6 – 9 PM Farewell Dinner is hosted at The Shipyard! Dazzle in shades of pink or flamingo print for tonight's theme. The night will finish off with the highly anticipated Flotilla Superlatives!

Dinner will consist of passed apps and a plated dinner choice of island chicken or fresh catch, plus an open bar from 6-9.
